

## Floor Tile and Edging Instructions

## Orient the Floor Tiles

Each tile has two pointed corners and two arrow-shaped corners. Begin at the front left corner of your space, where the screen will go. Set the first tile down with an <u>arrow-shaped corner</u> to the left. closest to the screen.

If you get that first step right, the rest of the floor will be easy as pie.

## 2) Lay the Rest of the Floor Tiles

Lay the rest of your tiles the same way. Don't overthink it - they only fit together one way.

## 3) Add the Edge Pieces

- Use the standard straight edge pieces (the ones that come with your floor tiles) anywhere you're not using the tall tapered edges.
- Install the tall tapered edge pieces as well they only go together one way too.

Each edge is also marked with L and R on the back, think of it as:

- L = Length of the room
- R = Row across the front/back
